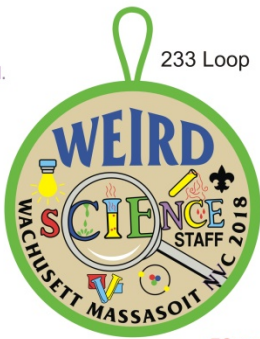

Late Registration - *\$10.00 per Scout(s)(patch included) And siblings if participating AFTER 6:PM FRIDAY Sept. 28, 2018*
